

METHODS OF COMMUNICATION

- Kindergarten - 1st grade: Puppets
Drug recognition: Look alike (candy/drugs) Substance pictures
(tobacco, alcohol, medications, food)
Always ask a trusted adult: Identify who are trusted adults
Story Telling: felt boards, story boards
- 2nd Grade: Body parts apron
Story reading
Puzzles
How to say what you really want
- 3rd Grade: Drug Clue Cards
Games
Alternative activity cards
Feeling Charades (how feelings are changed by use of drugs)
- 4th Grade: Ask Cards: True/False responses
Posters
Myths and Facts
Tell a Story with student participation

TEACHING THROUGH FUN

- PUPPETS: Hand made; stuffed animals; stick or sock puppets
- STORY BOARDS: Magazine figures; drawings made by children; clay; felt
- STORY BOOKS: Library; Make it up!
- PUZZLES: Make your own
- SONGS/MUSIC: Teach a song; Use a tape/CD; make your own; play an instrument
