

Submission must be completed by *December 31st 11:59p* ET. No late submission or email submissions will be accepted.

Participants are responsible for ensuring their device is setup to submit in required formats. Audio files must be in the MP3 digital audio format (.mp3). If you are using an Apple OS/Linux OS computer or some browsers and unwilling/able to adjust your personal device to create an .mp3 file, you may have to do your submission and then re-record your audio (5 minute max) on your computer, then manually convert the file to .mp3 and email it to vmayouthawareness@gmail.com by the deadline. Extensions for conversion will not be granted. It is recommended a Windows computer/browser is used to avoid formatting issues. The Youth Awareness team will not do the conversion. Audio files submitted in a different format are subject to scoring deduction.


